Hats



CHILD SAFE STANDARDS

Lalor East Primary School is committed to Child Safety. As a community we want children to be safe, happy and empowered. We support and respect all children, as well as our staff and volunteers. We are committed to the safety, participation and empowerment of all children. There is zero tolerance of child abuse, and all allegations and safety concerns will be treated very seriously and consistently with our robust policies and procedures. We meet our legal and moral obligations to contact authorities when we are worried about a child's safety, which we follow rigorously. Lalor East is committed to preventing child abuse and identifying risks early, and removing and reducing these risks. As a community we support and respect all children, as well as our staff and volunteers. There are new regulations around Working with Children Checks and we are proactive by ensuring that community members who work with children have a Working With Children Check. Additionally, we expect all volunteers, contractors, trainee teachers and visitors to the school to read the Child Code of Conduct when they sign in on our Compass Kiosk. Transition to Secondary School

Transition to secondary school forms for 2019 secondary school enrolment were sent home with all our Grade 6 students on Monday 29 April.

The application form must be returned to your child's teacher by **Monday 13 May 2019**. All students must list 3 secondary schools they wish to be considered for enrolment for 2019.


